GENERAL GUIDELINES

I. ABOUT

PINTA: The National Arts Contest

Pinta (to Draw) is the reinvented national arts contest with drawing (for elementary) and poster making (for secondary) events. Consciousness through art is a widely accepted methodology in promoting any form of advocacy. Through art, especially drawing or painting, participants to the event express their own understanding of a certain theme in a very expressive masterpiece that people admire. By injecting fire safety as a theme to arts contest open up a certain level of awareness to both the artist and audience.

II. MECHANICS

1. General Guidelines

- 1.1 The Drawing Contest is open to all elementary school students while the Poster Making Contest is open to all Junior and Senior High School students nationwide.
- 1.2 Entry pieces must illustrate an artistic interpretation of the general theme **“Matuto Ka. Sunog Iwasan Na!”**.
- 1.3 Must be drawn/illustrated in a ½ size (20x30 inches) illustration board (PORTRAIT LAYOUT) – Sizes shall be strictly observed, otherwise entry will be disqualified. Participants may use any form of art medium (oil pastel, crayons, colored pencil, paint etc.) for both drawing and poster making contest.
- 1.4 Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title with brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry.
- 1.5 All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID.
- 1.6 No identifying marks shall be allowed in all entries
- 1.7 All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size of exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said drawing/illustration.
- 1.8 The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.

2. Administration of Contest

- 2.1 Drawing contest can be held or facilitated by the city/municipal fire stations based on their capabilities and in due coordination with the LGU and the school administration.
- 2.2 Outputs from the station contest must be judged in their level and only the winners be transmitted for subsequent provincial or regional level judging/contest.
- 2.3 Only one winner from the regional level judging/contest must be submitted as finalist for the National Arts Contest.
- 2.4 The Chief, Regional CRS shall facilitate the formal transmittal of entries to the Fire Safety Information Division, BFP NHQ.

3. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING. The following criteria for each category shall be observed:

3.1 Drawing Contest

- **Theme Relevance** - 40%
Does the poster effectively communicate the CY 2020 Fire Prevention Month theme?
 - **Creativity and Originality** - 30%
Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality?
 - **Aesthetic Appeal** - 30%
Does the poster design captivate the judge's sense, Taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?

3.2 Poster Making Contest

- **Theme Relevance** - 40%
Does the poster effectively communicate the CY 2020 Fire Prevention Month theme?
 - **Creativity and originality** - 30%
Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality?
 - **Aesthetic Appeal** - 30%
Does the poster design captivate the judge's sense, taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?

III. NATIONAL SCREENING AND ARTS CONTEST EXHIBIT

1. The National Screening of the Feature Film Festival and Exhibition of the photo, drawing and poster making entries will be done during the 1st Fire Congress to be held on the 3rd week of July 2020.
2. The final judging will be held prior to the said event and the winners will be announced one week prior to the awarding ceremony. With the exemption of the feature film festival wherein the winners will be announced during the awarding ceremony.
3. Prizes for the winning entries on various contests shall be received by the winners or authorized representative from concerned Regional Offices. Transportation and accommodation for the winners shall be shouldered by the concerned Regional Offices.

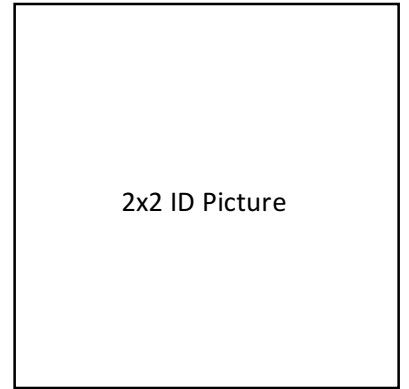
